LISBON SWIMMING POOL - PATRON RULES

- Anyone who enters pool area, including deck, must pay admission fee.
- All patrons must sign in before admittance to the pool, this includes Pass holders.
- Any child 8 years of age or younger must be accompanied by a guardian 12 years of age or older.
- Shower before entering the pool this will remove sweat, lotions, sunscreen, bacteria and organic matter. This means the chlorine in the pool won't have to work as hard, and more illnesses can be prevented.
- No food, glasses or breakable items allowed in pool area or in locker rooms.
- The pool may be closed at any time due to inclement weather or temperature below 68 degrees. Closures will be posted on the "Lisbon Park Board" Facebook site.
- Lifeguards may take a 10-minute break at the end of each hour. Patrons must exit the water during this time.
- Do not engage the lifeguard in unnecessary conversation.
- All children in the wading pool <u>must</u> be supervised by a parent or another person over the age of 12 within the wading pool enclosure.
- Infants are required to wear swim diapers in the pool.
- We allow the use of soft foam type balls in the pool except in the deep end. Please use caution when using these balls around other guests. Lifeguards have the right to limit use.
- Water games or activities that inconvenience others and/or may be considered dangerous to
 others are prohibited in the pool area. The decision as to whether an activity is considered
 dangerous or bothersome to others is left to the discretion of the lifeguards.
- Flotation devices are not allowed except for life jackets, arm floaties and baby floats with leg holes. Children using approved flotation devices must be supervised.
- Flotation devices (such as noodles and tubes) and other toys are only allowed during Pool Parties.
- Guests must be able to swim the length of the pool unassisted and without flotation devices to use the diving boards and rock-climbing wall during open hours.
- Only one person on a diving board at a time, must jump straight off board. Next diver may not step onto the ladder until the previous diver has jumped. Wait to jump until the previous diver reaches the ladder to exit pool.
- Only 2 rock climbers on the rock-climbing wall at a time. Wait to enter water until the previous climbers reach the ladder to exit the pool. Flips, dives and flotation devices are prohibited.
- No free swimming in the deep end except during Pool Parties or as designated by lifeguard on duty.
- Do not stand, play, or jump off ladders or stairs these are for patron entrance and exit only.
- No running, pushing, dunking, rough play or foul language in pool area or locker rooms.
- ANYONE not following rules will be given warnings as follows:
 - 1st Offense verbal warning
 - o 2nd Offense out of the pool for 30 minutes
 - o 3rd Offense asked to leave the pool for the day (if under 18, parents will be notified)
 - All warnings will be documented except for the 1st Offense.
